



83. God Does Not Lie

“God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent; has He said, and will He not do it? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?”

Numbers 23:19

God is holy. God is always truthful. God is perfect. God doesn't lie ... it is impossible for God to lie, Hebrews 6:18. He is God ... therefore, He cannot lie, Titus 2:2. The Bible is God's truthful Word, John 17:17.

God's words are pure, perfect, and right, Psalm 12:6 and 19:7-8. His Word is accurate to the smallest letter or stroke of a letter, Matthew 5:18.

This video continues teaching on prayer. God's written Word and God's answers to your prayers will never contradict each other. If they did, God would be a liar. A man asked me about a particular practice that he'd seen among Christians. I asked him what he'd do if I showed him verses that stated that such experiences were contrary to Biblical truth. He told me that, if he saw those verses, he would pray about being involved in that experience. I refused to answer his question. *Instead, I*

offered to teach him about the unchanging truthfulness of God. The Bible is God's Word ... it does not lie because God does not lie. God will never lead you to do something that contradicts His Word. God won't lie in His answers to your prayers. If God says one thing in His Word and you think He is contradicting that in His answer to your prayer, then the answer you are getting is not from God. Be careful!
