

5. In God's Hand

Jesus said, "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and I give eternal life to them, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand. My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand." That's from John 10:27-30.

Years ago, I was walking with my very young son. He stumbled and fell. I stood him back up ... and I held my hand out with two fingers extended down. He held my fingers and we started walking ... but again, he tripped. He wasn't strong enough to hold on. I stood him back up ... and told him, make a fist.
