The Amplified Bible expands it tp, "Be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the work of the Lord [always doing your best and doing more than is needed], being continually aware that your labor in the Lord is not futile nor wasted."

Will you come out of your isolation as a better Christian? Will you be more steadfast, immovable and abounding? It's not about time ... it's about discipline.
