

34. Let It Shine!

Jesus said, "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; nor does anyone light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house." That's Matthew 5:14&15.

Jesus had said (John 9:5), "While I am in the world, I am the Light of the world." And He passed the light on to us when He said, "You are the light of the world." We, as believers, are now the light of the world ... not to be hidden ... not to be covered. Our light should shine in the darkness of the lost world.

In Matthew 5:16 Jesus said, let your light shine "in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven."
