

59. A Dark Night of the Soul

Job said, "Behold, I go forward but He [God] is not there, and backward, but I cannot perceive Him; When He acts on the left, I cannot behold Him; He turns on the right, I cannot see Him. But He knows the way I take; when He has tried me, I shall come forth as gold. My foot has held fast to His path; I have kept His way and not turned aside. I have not departed from the command of His lips; I have treasured the words of His mouth more than my necessary food. But He is unique and who can turn Him? And what His soul desires, that He does," Job 23:8-13.

Does He seem to be unavailable, silent, distant, and unreachable? Jeremiah 23:23-24 tells us that God is
